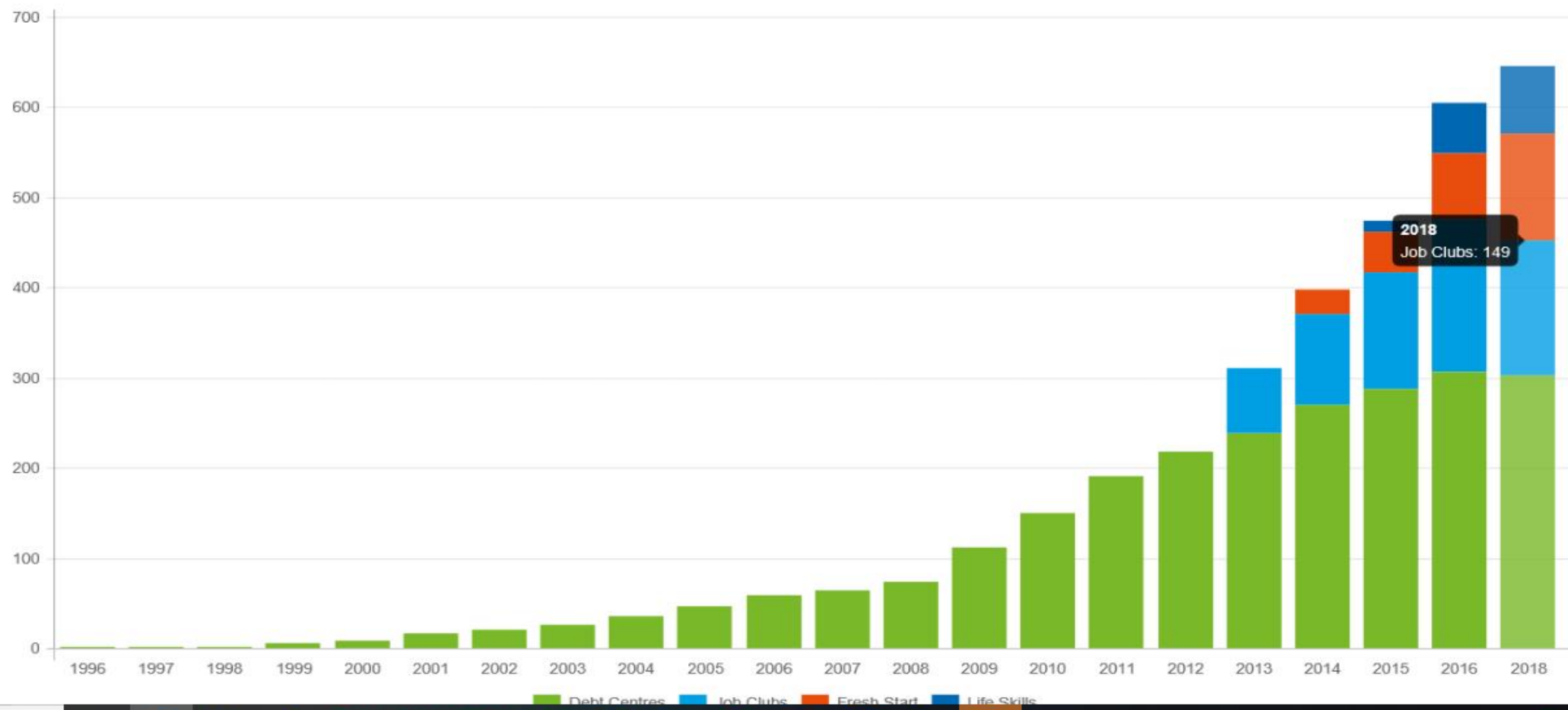

We're on a mission to serve the poor and save the lost with the Church across the nation.

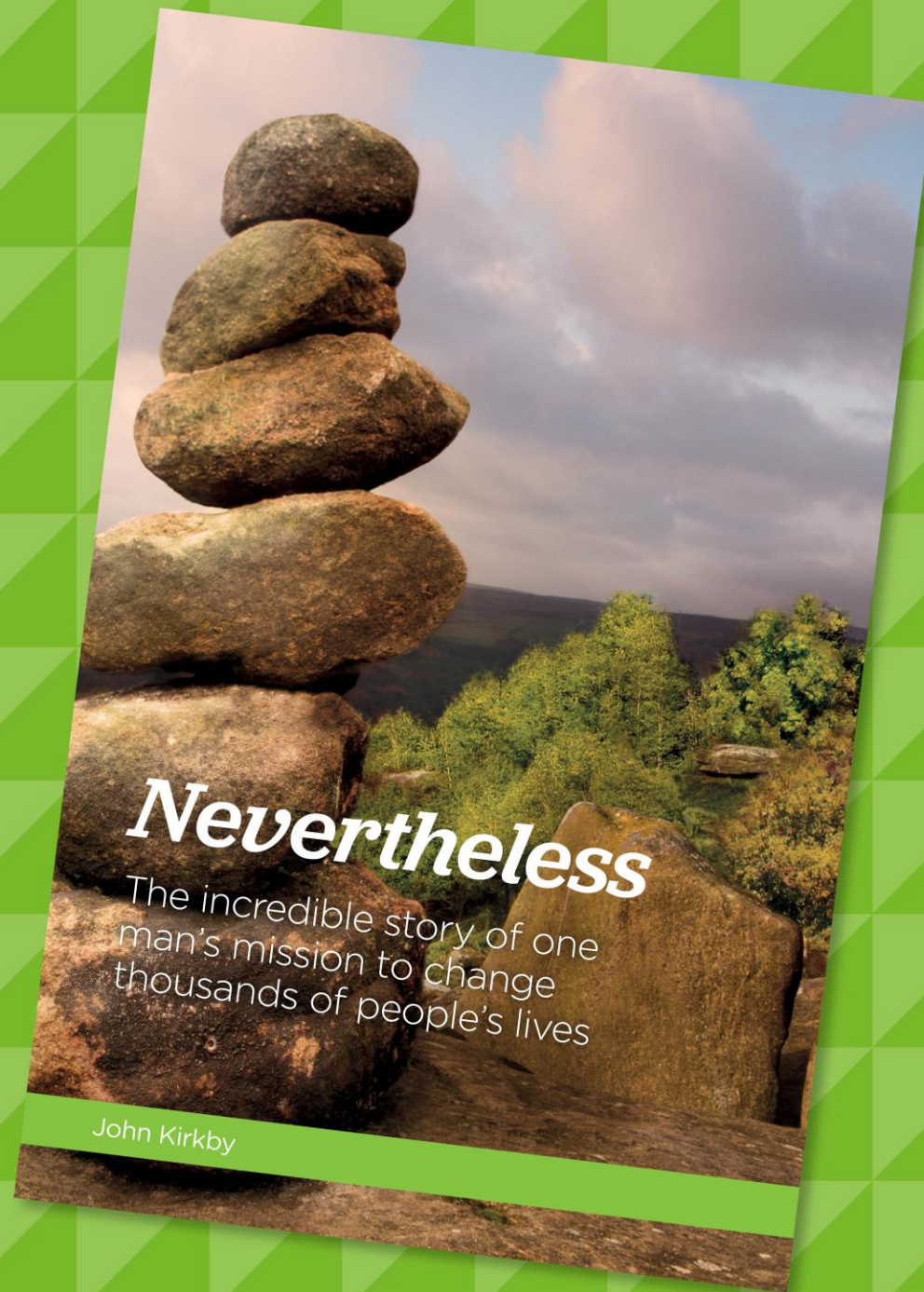
